Independent Living Council Questionnaire

1. The top issues of my campaign and my priorities for the next legislative session are strengthening the economy and creating job opportunities, reforming the health care system to increase access and affordability, and making Wisconsin a more affordable place to live.
2. I have been a co-author of past efforts on mental health parity. In a more recent effort at compromise, I voted for legislation that would have increased the limit on the amount of mandated mental health coverage under current law. I believe we need to make Wisconsin more equitable with other states in the coverage of mental health services.
3. As a member of the Joint Committee on Finance, I supported the Governor's budget recommendation to provide an additional \$12 million to fund SSI state supplemental benefits. We need to assist those who may be able to work to link them with job opportunities through our workforce development programs, and continue to provide a strong safety net for those unable to work.
- 4/6. As in all constituent services, my staff and I work with the appropriate state agencies and independent advocacy groups to assist constituents with their needs, making sure we follow through until there is a satisfactory resolution.
5. I have supported the expansion of Family Care so that the long term care needs of seniors and disabled citizens can be met in a manner most appropriate for each individual, with improved health outcomes and independence as a result. In addition, I voted on the Joint Finance Committee to increase funding for the Children's Long-Term Care Support program.
7. My door is always open to receive input and engage in a dialogue to discuss how we can work together to improve the lives and well-being of those for whom you advocate. I look forward to continuing that relationship in the next legislative session.
