Note: Voters who always need to vote absentee due to disability, age, or illness, may certify as indefinitely confined to become a permanent absentee voter. The clerk will send the voter an absentee ballot automatically for every election, unless the voter fails to return a ballot. If that occurs, the clerk must send the voter a letter giving notice the voter will be removed from the permanent list within 30 days if the voter does not reapply. Indefinitely confined voters are not required to provide photo ID.
